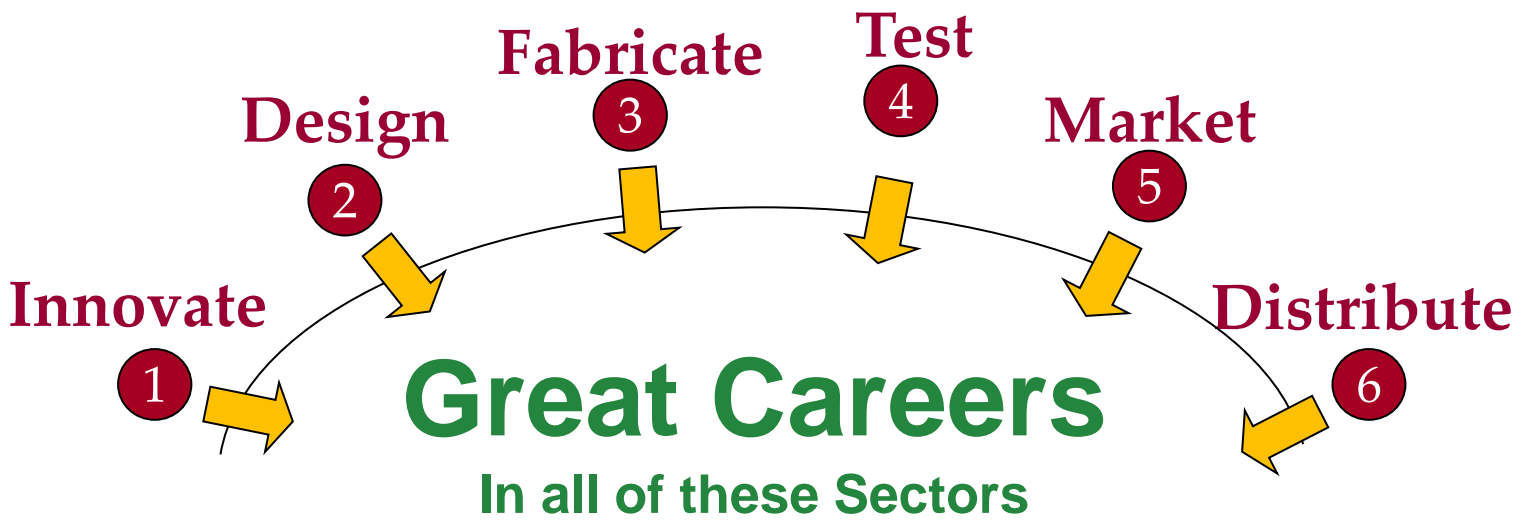




What is manufacturing?
